POSITION: Fisheries Aide – Fall 2024

WAGE: \$15.00 Per Hour (1-4) Years of Service
\$16.00 Per Hour (5-9) Years of Service
\$17.00 Per Hour (10+) Years of Service

Note: This position has been classified as 100% exempt for qualified tribal members under Internal Revenue Code s.7873 – Tax Exemption for Income Derived from Treaty Fishing Rights-Related Activities. See GLIFWC website for current benefit information.

CLOSING DATE: **AUGUST 30, 2024, or until filled.**

SUPERVISION: Reports to GLIFWC Inland Fisheries Biologist.

CLASSIFICATION: Limited Term Employee, dates of employment are not fixed but will run approximately from the beginning of September to mid-October.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assist with electrofishing surveys (typically at night) of walleye recruitment in ceded territory lakes and perhaps rivers. Persons will help launch and operate boats, dip fish, and collect biological information. The ability to travel for up to 3 consecutive weeks is required. Overnight lodging, per diem, and mileage will be paid. Must be willing to share overnight lodging accommodations with co-workers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ability to identify gamefish and panfish. Persons will be expected to follow safety guidelines, to collect information in an efficient manner, and record data neatly and accurately. Vehicle and driver's license preferred but not required. Persons who have submitted an application for this position in the past need not send another application. However, these persons must call or write a letter stating their interest in the position.

Indian preference will be applied consistent with GLIFWC policies and the Federal Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (PL 93-638).
