DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Write a story for the Mazina'igan (talking papers).
2. Assist with comparative ogaa (walleye) recruitment study (electrofishing and limnological surveys).
3. Conduct in-lake and watershed habitat surveys.
4. Draft summary reports of habitat surveys.
5. Assist with ashigan (largemouth bass) population estimates.
6. Assist with fish community surveys.
7. Assist with multi-being/species telemetry project in Mille Lacs.
8. Field work is expected to include a telemetry project on fishes in Mille Lacs, data collection for a comparative walleye recruitment study, and habitat surveys for lakes and watersheds that are in need of rehabilitation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- An interest in fisheries management and research.
- Experience with data collection and entry.
- An ability to work long hours in adverse conditions.
