DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position will focus on the day-to-day duties of a GLIFWC Conservation warden. These duties may include:

- 1) Patrol with current field wardens.
- 2) Organizing and maintaining equipment.
- 3) Scheduling, participating, and documenting Division trainings.
- 4) Assisting in community outreach events facilitated by the Enforcement Division.
- 5) Updating Warden inventory.
- 6) Assisting with grant management.
- 7) Camp Counselor at Camp Onji-Akiing.
- 8) Daily records management review & monthly administrative report.
- 9) Participate in mandatory GLIFWC activities that include orientation and training, first aid training, and other traditional/educational activities.
- 10) Must be flexible with scheduling and other duties assigned.

This work will take place throughout the Ceded Territory in Wisconsin, Minnesota, and Michigan. The intern will be expected to work cooperatively with GLIFWC wardens, state agencies, federal agencies, and tribal agencies. Field work may be conducted under strenuous conditions (temperatures, weather conditions, time of day, insects, etc.). Must be available to work evening, night, and weekend hours. Some clothing and equipment will be provided for use during these times.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be enrolled in an accredited college or technical school.
- Ability to perform duties based on the season/activities occurring at the time and to work in occasional adverse environmental conditions (heat, insects, etc.).
