

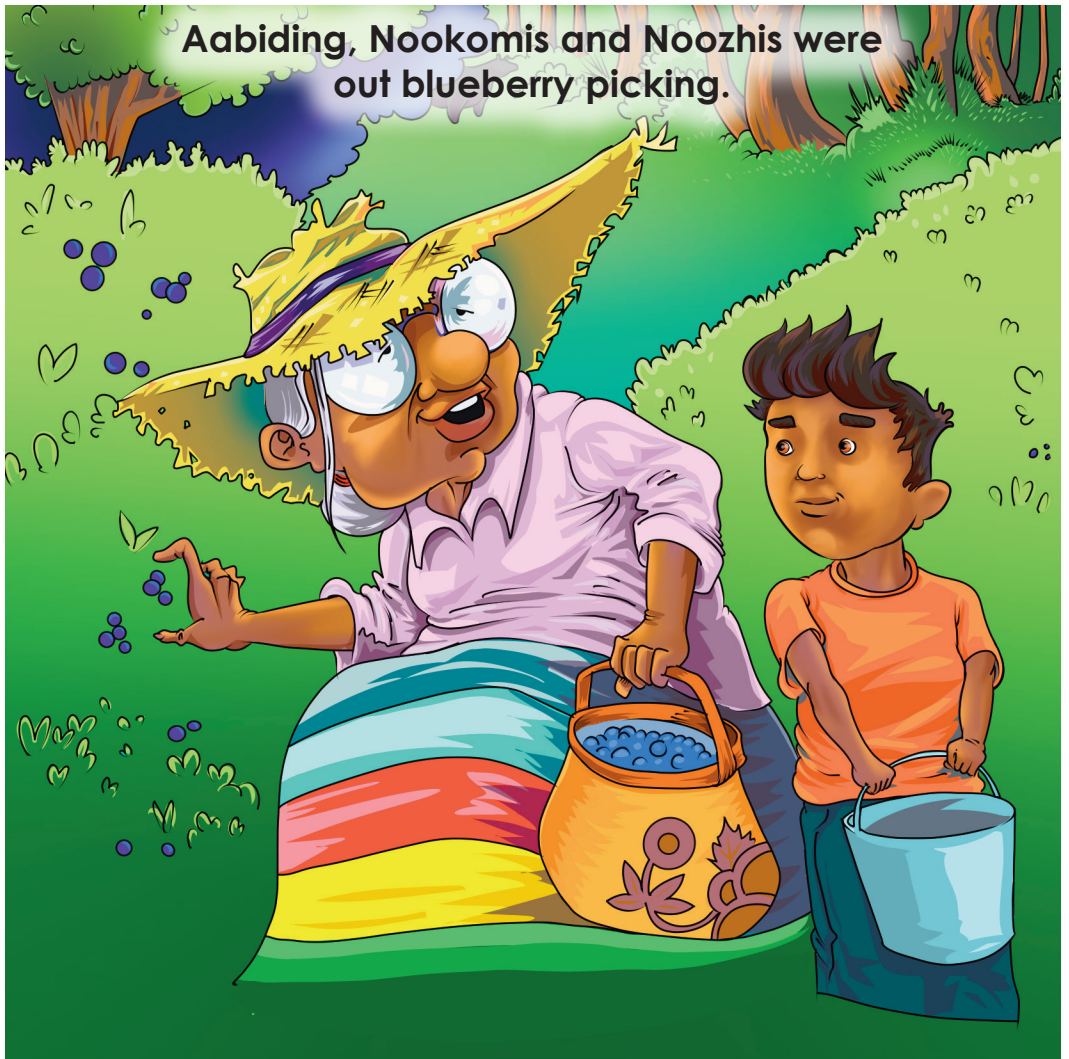

Nookomis starts telling Noozhis the story.



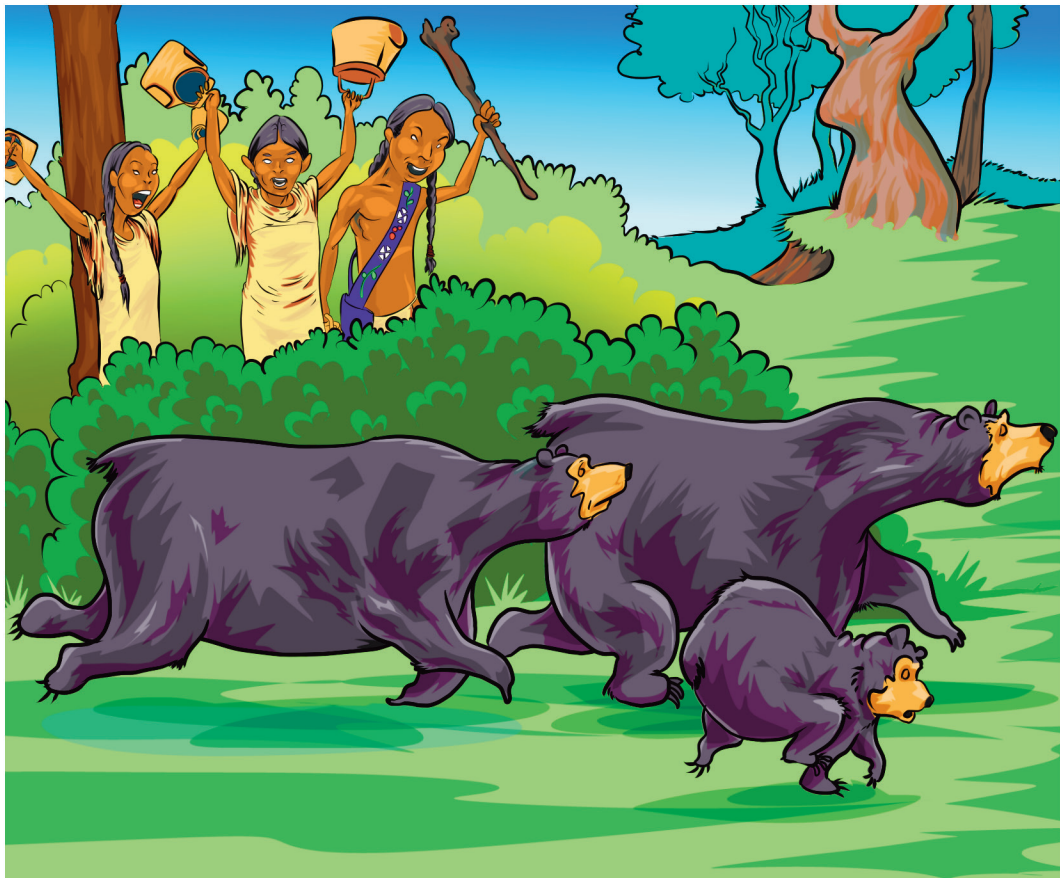
**“Aabiding, niswi makwag went out looking for food.

Maama Makwa, Dede Makwa, and Makoons.”**



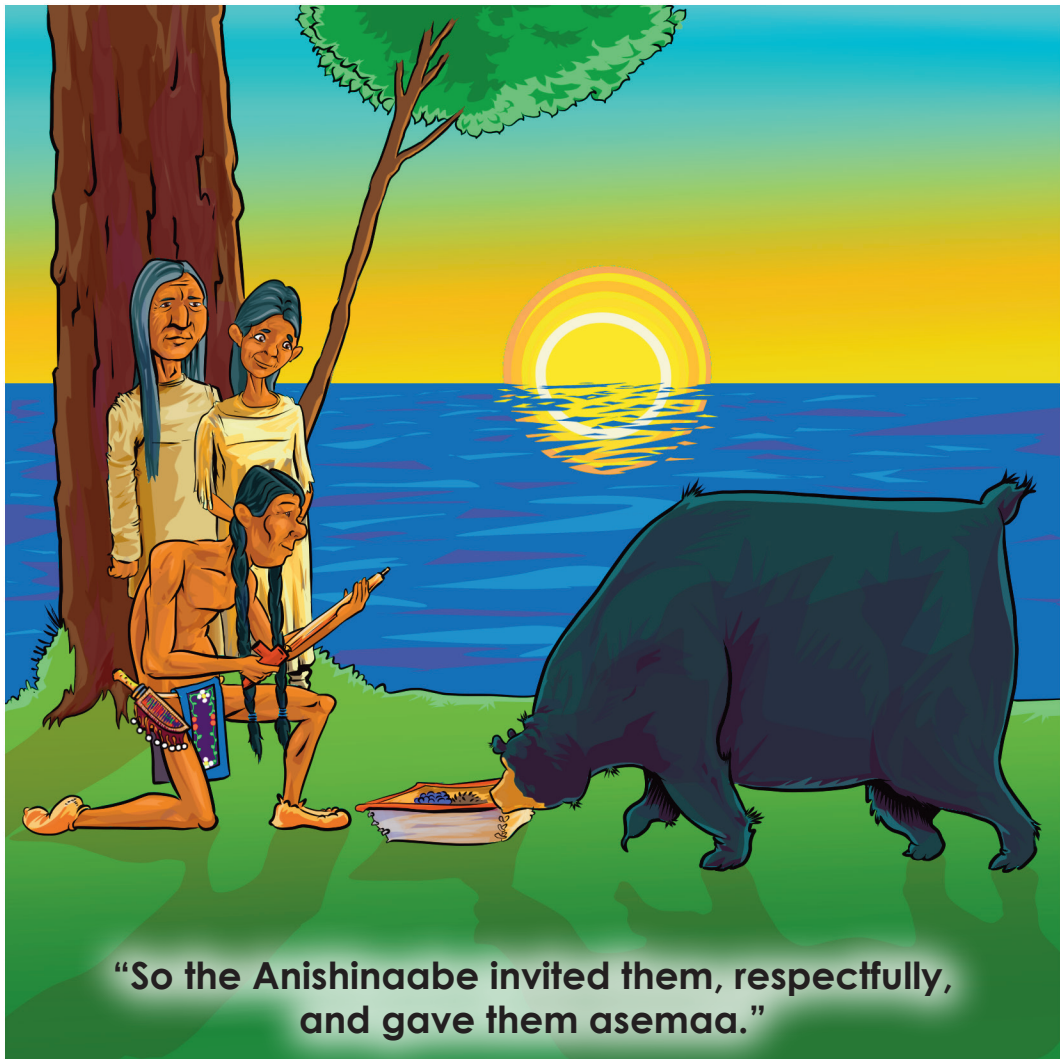
**“They travelled to Mooningwanekaaning.

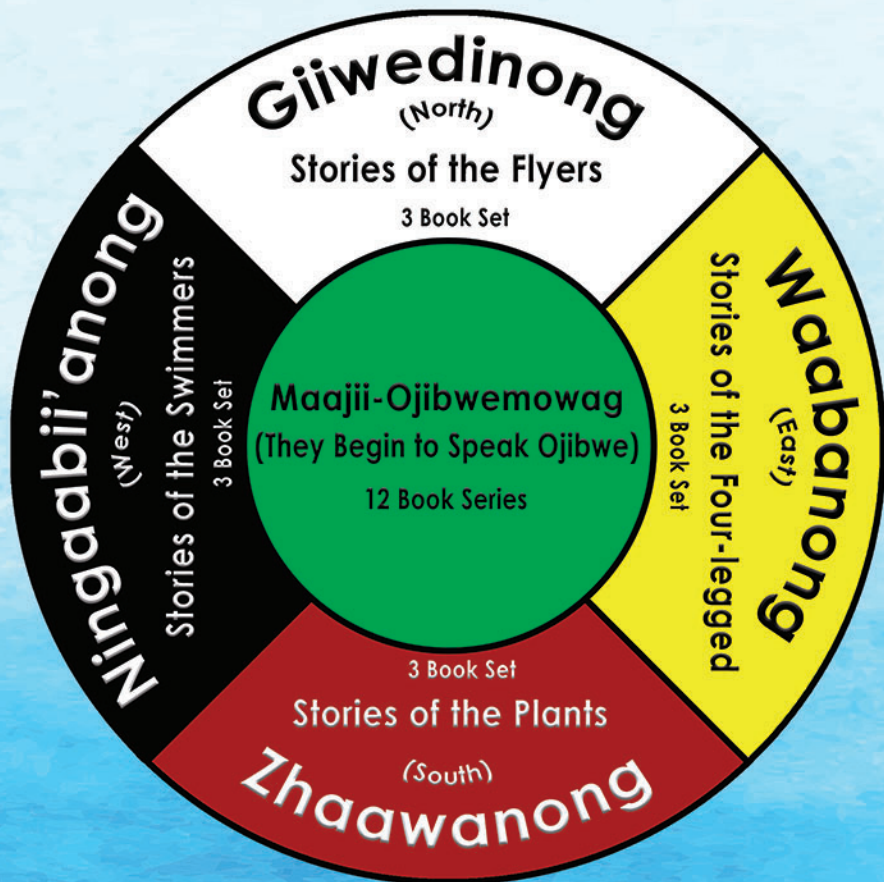
