To Register:

1. Log in to WI DNR Go Wild or create an account:
gowild.wi.gov
2. Click "MANAGE SAFETY EDUCATION"
then "Search for Class"
3. Course type: "Hunter Internet Field Day"
County: "Sawyer"
4. Select "Enroll" on the class matching the date
and location. A message at the top of the screen
should now say "Success! You have successfully
enrolled in the class."

Online:

This is a hybrid course, which includes an online class portion and an in-person field day portion for completion of the class. **Students must complete the online portion of the class prior to attending the field portion.**

1. Go to hunter-ed.com/wisconsin-hunt. The page displayed should say "Official Wisconsin Hunter Internet Field Day Online Course"
2. Click "Online + Field Day" and create an account using the WI DNR customer number found on the WI DNR GoWild account page.
3. Complete the online course and **print the certificate of completion.**

In Person:

Bring **\$10 fee** for in-person field day, **certificate of completion** for online portion, and **appropriate clothing** for the weather as much of the field day will be outside.
