## To Register:

1. Log in to WI DNR Go Wild or create an account:  
*gowild.wi.gov*
2. Click “**MANAGE SAFETY EDUCATION**”  
then “**Search for Class**”
3. Course type: “**Hunter Internet Field Day**”  
County: “**Vilas**”
4. Select “**Enroll**” on the class matching the date  
and location. A message at the top of the screen  
should now say “Success! You have successfully  
enrolled in the class.”

## Online:

This is a hybrid course, which includes an online class portion and an in-person field day portion for completion of the class. **Students must complete the online portion of the class prior to attending the field portion.**

1. Go to *hunter-ed.com/wisconsin-hunt*. The page displayed should say  
“Official Wisconsin Hunter Internet Field Day Online Course”
2. Click “**Online + Field Day**” and create an account using the WI DNR  
customer number found on the WI DNR GoWild account page.
3. Complete the online course and **print the certificate of completion.**

## In Person:

Bring **\$10 fee** for in-person field day, **certificate of completion** for online portion, and **appropriate clothing** for the weather as much of the field day will be outside.
