Order No. 2026-04

Wisconsin 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territory Alternative Monitoring of Muskellunge

This Commission Order addresses the alternative monitoring of muskellunge on certain waterbodies in the Wisconsin portion of the 1837 and 1842 ceded territory pursuant to agreements of the Parties to the *LCO* case in accordance with *Section 3.e.* of the *Stipulation for Biological and Certain Other Issues* (Docket Number 911) as amended by *Section X* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Second Amendment of the Stipulations Incorporated in the Final Judgement* and *Section I.C.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement*.

Sec. 1: Authority and Applicability; Purpose and Limitations.

Subd. 1.1: This Order is issued in accordance with the authority granted in *Section I.A.1.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Sixth Amendment to the Stipulations Incorporated Into the Final Judgement* which provides the GLIFWC Executive Administrator with the authority to issue a Commission Order on any topic so long as the Parties have agreed to the substance of the Order and the applicability of the Commission Order process.

Subd. 1.2: *Section I.C.a.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement* provides that lakes with a maximum safe harvest of eight (8) muskellunge may be eligible for alternative monitoring. While the Stipulation language provides for incremental increase to the eligible waterbodies for walleye from the original eligibility numbers, no such increase potential was included for muskellunge. This creates a situation where some waterbodies may be eligible for alternative monitoring for walleye while they are simultaneously not eligible alternative monitoring of muskellunge. This Order is intended to ameliorate this discrepancy and provide for more efficient alternative monitoring for all fish species.

Subd. 1.3: Upon issuance of this Order, unless a Tribe chooses to adopt more restrictive measures, the regulations established herein shall be the Tribe's regulations as provided in the *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Walleye Harvest on Certain Lakes in the Wisconsin portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories* document as enacted in each Tribe's Code.


Sec. 2: Alternative Monitoring of Muskellunge. Starting on the date of this Order and unless and until changed by a subsequent order, or made permanent through an amendment to the stipulations, the following shall apply to each signatory tribe:

Subd. 2.1: The applicable language in *Section I.C.a.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement* shall be temporarily superseded to permit the list of waterbodies eligible for alternative monitoring of muskellunge to include waterbodies with a maximum safe harvest, or remaining quota (see Commission Order 2026-03), of eleven (11) muskellunge.

Subd. 2.2: The tribal administrative document *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Open-Water Spearing on Certain Lakes in the Wisconsin Portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories - 2026* (attached) shall be amended in accordance with changes detailed in *Subd. 2.1*, above.

Sec. 3: Reservation of Each Tribe's Authority. Nothing in this order is intended to, or shall be construed to, limit the authority of each Tribe to establish tribal gathering regulations or other measures that are more restrictive than provided in this Order.

Order No. 2026-03

Wisconsin 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territory Alternative Monitoring Eligibility by Remaining Quota

This Commission Order addresses the eligibility of lakes for alternative monitoring during the 2026 open-water spearing season in the Wisconsin portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories pursuant to agreements of the Parties to the *LCO* case in accordance with *Section 3.e.* of the *Stipulation for Biological and Certain Other Issues* (Docket Number 911) as amended by *Section X* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Second Amendment of the Stipulations Incorporated in the Final Judgement* and *Section I.C.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement*.

Sec. 1: Authority and Applicability; Purpose and Limitations.

Subd. 1.1: This Order is issued in accordance with the authority granted in *Section I.A.1.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Sixth Amendment to the Stipulations Incorporated Into the Final Judgement*, which provides GLIFWC's Executive Administrator with the authority to issue a Commission Order on any topic so long as the Parties have agreed to the substance of the Order and the applicability of the Commission Order process.

Subd. 1.2: *Section I.C.a.* of the *Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement* provides that lakes may be eligible for alternative monitoring and included in the administrative document *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Open-Water Spearing on Certain Lakes in the Wisconsin Portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories* based on a specified maximum safe-harvest number for walleye and/or muskellunge. To support effective tribal harvest and monitoring, specifically on lakes with small remaining quotas, this Order allows waterbodies to become eligible for alternative monitoring when the remaining quota for walleye and/or muskellunge on that waterbody falls below the number agreed upon by the Parties.

Subd. 1.3: Upon issuance of this Order, unless a Tribe chooses to adopt more restrictive measures, the regulations established herein shall be the Tribe's regulations as provided in the *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Open-Water Spearing on Certain Lakes in the Wisconsin portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories* document as enacted in

each Tribe's Code. The regulations established herein shall be in operation for a one-year trial period unless otherwise agreed upon by the Parties.


Sec. 2: Alternative Monitoring by Remaining Quota. Starting on the date of this Order and applying for one year, unless and until changed by a subsequent order, or made permanent through an amendment to the stipulations, the following shall apply to each signatory tribe:

Subd. 2.1: The applicable language in *Section I.C.a. of the Stipulation for Technical, Management and Other Updates: Fourth Amendments to the Stipulations Incorporated into the Final Judgement* shall be temporarily superseded to permit the eligibility of waterbodies for alternative monitoring of walleye and muskellunge be determined based on remaining quota numbers agreed upon by the Parties. These remaining quota numbers shall be reflected in the tribal administration document detailed in *Subd. 2.2*, below.

Subd. 2.2: The tribal administrative document *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Open-Water Spearing on Certain Lakes in the Wisconsin Portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories - 2026* (attached) shall be amended in accordance with changes detailed in *Subd. 2.1*, above.

Sec. 3: Reservation of Each Tribe's Authority. Nothing in this order is intended to, or shall be construed to, limit the authority of each Tribe to establish tribal harvesting regulations or other measures that are more restrictive than provided in this Order.

INTRODUCTION

The intent of this publication is to provide a readily accessible means of identifying waterbodies that are open in the spring of 2026 to *Tribal Alternative Monitoring of Open-Water Spearing in the Wisconsin Portion of the 1837 and 1842 Ceded Territories* applicable to the Voigt Treaty Off-Reservation Conservation Code.

REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS

In the areas designated as open for the alternative monitoring of open-water spearing within the portion of the ceded territory located in the State of Wisconsin, no member shall harvest walleye or muskellunge in the spring by the method of open-water spearing, without a monitoring team present, unless that waterbody is designated as an alternatively monitored waterbody for that night, and the member(s) maintain compliance with the procedures listed in this document and Chapter 9 of the applicable Off-Reservation Conservation Code. In regard to any permit issued, a member must comply with all regulations established in Chapter 9 of the applicable Off-Reservation Conservation Code and must also comply with all other terms and conditions of the permit as imposed by the Tribe.

No member shall harvest walleye or muskellunge in the spring of 2026 by the method of open-water spearing, without a monitoring team present, on any waterbody except those as defined in this document as eligible (see pg. 4) and in accordance with the following principles:

- (a) The tribes shall recommend that tribal prosecutors charge in such a way so that tribal members caught in violation of this provision receive a minimum of a one-year revocation of their treaty reserved harvesting rights upon successful prosecution.
- (b) Any tribe seeking to designate, for open-water spearing, an eligible waterbody as an alternatively monitored waterbody, the Tribal Conservation Department, or designee, shall provide notice to the DNR the name of the waterbody that tribes have designated for open-water spearing that night, and of the walleye and muskellunge bag limit for each waterbody to be fished, in accordance with Sec. 5.00 of the Voigt Intertribal Task Force Protocol on Walleye and Muskellunge Harvest Levels.
- (c) In the event that a tribe has designated a waterbody for alternative monitoring and issues no open-water spearing permits for that night, the tribal conservation department, or its designee, shall provide notice to the DNR by 6:00 p.m. that day, in accordance with sec. 5.10 of the Voigt Intertribal Task Force Protocol on Walleye and Muskellunge Harvest Levels.
- (d) Each Tribe may only designate for alternative monitoring, four (4) eligible waterbodies per night. However, after appropriate data, information and study on the compliance and enforcement of this stipulation, and upon consultation with and

approval of the State, the Tribes may incrementally increase the number of waterbodies designated for alternative monitoring per night, by each tribe, to ten (10) eligible waterbodies.

(e) Any Tribe seeking to designate for spring spearing an eligible waterbody shall designate a creel team to be present at a specific location, or at the tribal registration station, provided:

(i) The specific location of the creel team shall be determined and communicated to the permittee at the time the permit is issued.

(ii) The creel team shall remain on duty at the specified location until the alternatively monitored permit(s) that the creel team is responsible for is turned in and the fish harvested are creeled, or notice is provided by the Biological Services Division or Conservation Enforcement Division that the creel team is released for the night.

(f) A tribal member may only be issued for that night, an alternatively monitored permit for open-water spearing on an eligible waterbody, before the tribal member is issued a spring spearing permit monitored on-site (at the landing) or netting permit(s) for that night, except that a member may be issued a netting permit to allow for setting of nets only. Once a tribal member has been issued an open-water spearing permit monitored on-site (at the landing), that member may not receive, for that same night, an alternative monitoring permit for open-water spearing. Likewise, a tribal member may not receive an alternative monitoring permit for open-water spearing for that night if that member will be required to lift nets that night, pursuant to an active netting permit.

(i) For the purpose of this section “night” shall be defined as the time between one hour after sunset on one day, and one hour before sunrise on the following day; and the time of sunset and sunrise shall be ascertained according to the mean solar time of the ninetieth meridian west from Greenwich, commonly known as central time, as given in any almanac.

(g) A tribal member may only possess one (1) alternatively monitored permit for an eligible waterbody at any one time and the tribal member may not be in the simultaneous possession of any other outstanding open-water spearing or netting permit, except that a member may be in possession for a netting permit for the purposes of setting nets only.

WATERBODIES ELIGIBLE FOR THE ALTERNATIVE MONITORING OF OPEN-WATER SPEARING WITHIN THE PORTION OF THE CEDED TERRITORIES LOCATED IN THE STATE OF WISCONSIN FOR BOTH OGAA AND MAAZHKINOOZHE.

Walleye: Any waterbody with a remaining quota of no more than two hundred (200) walleye shall be eligible to be declared by a Tribe for alternative monitoring of walleye.

Muskellunge: Any waterbody with a remaining quota of no more than eleven (11) muskellunge shall be eligible to be declared by a Tribe for alternative monitoring of muskellunge.

NOTE ON ALTERNATIVE MONITORING ELIGIBILITY BY REMAINING QUOTA

2026 Season: During the 2026 open-water spearing season, a Tribe may declare a waterbody to be alternatively monitored pursuant to the waterbody's remaining quota as a secondary eligibility criterion to its safe harvest level. **Attached** is a table of waterbodies with a walleye safe harvest of no more than 200 and a muskellunge safe harvest of no more than 11. This list reflects the waterbodies **initially eligible** for alternative monitoring.

Additional waterbodies may become eligible for alternative monitoring of walleye when their remaining quota for walleye falls to 200 or below. Furthermore, additional waterbodies may become eligible for alternative monitoring of muskellunge when their remaining quota for muskellunge falls to 11 or below. A waterbody that is eligible for alternative monitoring for walleye may sometimes not be eligible for alternative monitoring for muskellunge, unless the waterbody's remaining quota (or safe harvest number) for muskellunge is also eligible (i.e. remaining quota of 11 or fewer), and vice versa.

Use of remaining quota may be applied in subsequent years upon agreement of the parties through the issuance of a Commission Order or made permanent through an amendment to the stipulations.
